SHOW RULES

GENERAL

- 1. Orchidexpo 20243 is sanctioned by the American Orchid Society (AOS), following the rules of the AOS Handbook on Judging and Exhibition and the provisional rules of the AOS Judging Committee.
- 2. Upon registration, each exhibitor agrees to abide by all the rules of this show.
- 3. Any question or litigation with respect to the interpretation or the application of the present rules or those of the AOS must be submitted to the Orchidexpo Chairman or the Head of Judging, as appropriate. Their decisions are final and without appeal. For any interpretation or application of the present rules, the French version of the Show rules takes precedence over this English version.
- 4. Exhibitors must request the space needed for their exhibit and the number of sales tables required. Their formal request must be made in writing to:

- 5. Les Orchidophiles de Montréal and College Ahuntsic are not responsible for any theft or damage to plants, flowers, pots, exhibits, goods or objects belonging to exhibitors and other participants. However, all possible necessary precautions will be taken to prevent such losses or damages.
- 6. Access to the Exhibition Hall and sales area is free of charge to all members of Les Orchidophiles de Montréal wearing their valid membership card.
- 7. Any registered vendor who withdraws before the start of the Show:
 - Will not be reimbursed for the rental cost of his sales tables, and
 - If he wishes to register for a subsequent year, he will have to pay the full cost of renting his sales tables no later than December 31 preceding this future edition of Orchidexpo. These fees will not be refundable.

PLANTS AND OTHER ITEMS REGISTRATION

- 8. Upon arrival on site, all exhibitors shall go to Les Orchidophiles de Montréal's Front desk ('*Table d'accueil*) to get their exhibit location, their sales table location if applicable, and other documents.
- 9. Registration and help form organizers are free of charge.
- 10. Only exhibits, plants and other duly registered items will be judged. In addition, registrations that do not respect the official classification will be disqualified.
- 11. Any plant or cut flower shipment by exhibitors not attending the show in person for exhibition purposes by Les Orchidophiles de Montréal must be received before 6:00 PM, Friday, March 15, 2024. Arrangements must be made with the Orchidexpo Chairman at least one week prior to the Show.

- 12. Any material to be returned at the request of an exhibitor will be at his own expenses. The Show Director shall dispose as he sees fit of any material not claimed or for which no arrangements will have been made with respect to its return.
- 13. Registration for judging purposes will follow the **REGISTRATION PROCEDURE** below.
- 14. No registration will be accepted for judging after **8:00 PM, Friday, March 15, 2024**. Articles not registered in due time will be exhibited but will not be judged during the Saturday Ribbon/Trophy judging.
- 15. Classes are open to all, except those which require an eligibility condition as outlined in the LIST OF CLASSES, TROPHIES & ROSETTES below.
- 16. Any registration in Classes C001, C002, C003 and C004 (Amateur Exhibits) can also be made in Class C006 (Orchid Society Exhibit) if applicable.
- 17. An «Amateur» is a person cultivating orchids as a hobby and who does not sell more than fifty (50) orchids per year.
- 18. Any plant submitted for judging must have been owned by the exhibitor since at least three (3) months.
- 19. The Class in which a plant shall be registered is the one with the smallest possible Class number, as appropriate in the LIST OF CLASSES, TROPHIES & ROSETTES below.
- 20. «Hybrid» means an intrageneric hybrid made from more than one species of the same genus. «Intergeneric hybrid» means a hybrid made of species belonging to different genera.
- 21. An orchid can only be registered in one Class. However,
 - an orchid registered in Class C308 (Fragrance) can also be registered in another Class (C015 to C119);
 - an orchid registered in Class C119 (Seedling blooming for the first time) can also be registered in another Class (C015 to C117; C308)
- 22. Entries in the Artistic Division (Classes C300 to C306; C309) must be the exhibitor's original creations.

EXHIBITS

- 23. Exhibits **must be registered**, as must the orchids contained therein.
- 24. Reasonable efforts will be made to give each exhibitor the space requested for his exhibit.
- 25. Vendors selling orchids during the Show must set-up an exhibit of a size proportional to the number of sales tables they are using. These tables are available at a cost set out in the registration form.
- 26. Tables for exhibits will be provided free of charge. However, canvas, decorative greenery and others props required for the exhibit shall be provided by the exhibitor.

- 27. No screen, divider, textile or partition is supplied. Nothing can be suspended or fixed to existing walls or black curtains. Exhibitors must supply all their exhibit materials. Any reasonable material is allowed.
- 28. The Orchidophiles de Montreal will provide ant install decorative lighting for the exhibits. However, if an exhibitor wishes to use his own lighting system, he shall have it approved by the Orchidexpo Chairman. Any lighting modifying the flowers' colors will be turned off during judging.
- 29. All exhibitors' identification signs will be supplied by Les Orchidophiles de Montréal. No other type of identification will be allowed in the Exhibition Hall.
- 30. Set-up is allowed during the scheduled period. All plants must be in place by **midnight on Friday, March 15, 2024**.
- 31. Orchids shall be the only flowering plants in exhibits, except for cut flowers arrangements and corsages where orchids shall nonetheless predominate.
- 32. Any plant to be judged shall be identified by its genus and species name and, in the case of hybrids, by its hybrid name. Awarded orchids must be identified to that effect.
- 33. The Orchidexpo Chairman has the right to remove any exhibit or part thereof if he deems it to be of insufficient quality.
- 34. All plants, exhibits and other objects on display must remain in place until **4:15 PM on Sunday March 17, 2024**, whether have they been sold or not.

JUDGING

- 35. Only judges, judging assistants and authorized personnel can be present on the exhibition floor during judging.
- 36. Judges and judging assistants shall familiarize themselves with these show rules.
- 37. Ribbons will be given to the First, Second and Third places of each Class at the Judges' discretion; however, only one First place ribbon can be awarded for each Class. Rosettes and/or Trophies will be given as indicated in the **LIST OF CLASSES**, **TROPHIES & ROSETTES** below.
- 38. Judges have the authority to award or not any ribbon, prize or trophy, as well as to subdivide any Class.
- 39. In addition to ribbons and/or trophies awarded by the Judges, plants and flowers can potentially receive mentions from the AOS. When submitting a plant or an exhibit to AOS judging, the exhibitor agrees to receive such mention(s) and pay the associated costs to the AOS. If the exhibitor does not wish to receive such mention(s), he must specify "No AOS judging" on the registration form. A plant previously submitted to an AOS judging cannot be judged again by the AOS with the same inflorescences and shall also be flagged "No AOS judging".
- 40. With the agreement of the Head of Judging and the Orchidexpo Chairmen, registration tags must be removed from the exhibits at the end of the judging period and before the public admission.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Exhibits, plants, and other items must be registered according to the following procedure:

ONLINE REGISTRATION

- Registration for judging purposes will PREFERABLY be done directly on the Society's website (<u>https://www.orchidophilesmontreal.com/registration</u>) between Friday March 8, 2024 and Friday March 15, 2024 at 3PM at the latest.
- 2. Once registration is completed on the Society's website, the exhibitor clicks on the 'SUBMIT' button at the bottom of the screen and a window will appear indicating the number of items registered and a message confirming that they will receive by email the PDF list of its WHITE labels to affix to each registered item. No additional registration confirmation will be sent by email.
- 3. If received before March 14, 2024, the exhibitor is encouraged to print its white labels BEFORE arriving at the show grounds. If the exhibitor has not previously printed its white labels, or if registration was made AFTER March 14, 2024, they will be available on site in the Registration room.
- 4. The exhibitor is responsible for immediately checking its white labels and immediately reporting any errors to Registration Clerks so that the necessary corrections can be made before the end of the registration period.

REGISTRATION ON PAPER

- 5. EXCEPTIONALLY, the paper registration form provided by Les Orchidophiles de Montréal can be used on site and in person on **Friday March 15, 2024, from 3PM to 8PM.** This form is also available in PDF format on the Society's website.
- 6. If the exhibitor uses the paper form provided by Les Orchidophiles de Montréal. He must:
 - WRITE LEGIBLY.
 - Enter his name and, if applicable, that of the Orchid Society he represents;

Each exhibitor in a group or Society exhibit must use a separate Form and receive their own exhibitor number (Exhibitor #). However, there will only be one exhibit number (Stand #) for a group exhibit.

• Enter the Class number (Class #) for each item registered:

A Class number search application is available during the online registration procedure on the website. A list of genera and corresponding Classes is also available in paper format in the Registration room. These tools also make it possible to identify a Class for each species of Dendrobium and Paphiopedilum.

IF IN DOUBT, ASK FOR HELP!!!

• Enter the name of each plant on display. If the plant is a hybrid not registered with the RHS, enter the name of the parents of the cross. If the plant has received an award, enter the acronym of the award (AM, HCC, FCC, etc.).

DO NOT WRITE ANYTHING IN THE OTHER BOXES.

7. Once completed, return the paper registration form to the Registration Clerks. You will then be assigned an exhibit number (Kiosque), an exhibitor number (Exposant) and a label number (Étiquette (#)) for each item registered.

REGISTRATION OF PLANTS IN THE ORCHIDOPHILES DE MONTRÉAL DISPLAYS

- 8. There are 3 exhibits for Les Orchidophiles de Montréal as follows:
 - The main exhibit
 - The miniature orchids exhibit
 - The fragrant orchid exhibit
- 9. Members who wish to display an orchid in one of these exhibits must register it themselves BEFORE taking it to the location where the exhibits will be installed.
- 10. Registration labels will be provided to the persons responsible for each exhibit at the very end of the registration period.
